



CATERING & BAR

- Entry fees are inclusive of coffee / tea on arrival. Visitors entry fee entitles a visitor to one drink at the bar on the day of play: upon registration, the visitor will be issued with a voucher to be exchanged at the bar for a *drink of their choice (*single glass of wine / pint of beer or lager / single measure of spirit & mixer / soft drink of choice).
- The cost of a full English breakfast is £8.00pp, available daily from 8.30am.
Please note: all breakfast requirements between 7am and 8.30am MUST be pre-ordered on the booking form.
- Catering facilities are available from 8.30am until 4.30pm daily. Catering required before or after these hours should be notified to the kitchen. For all dietary requirements and allergy advice, please contact the caterers direct on 01795 890561 – option 5.
- The bar will be open from 10.30am until 10pm daily.

COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

- All competitions will be played under the Rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club in conjunction with the local rules of Faversham Golf Club. The decisions of the Competitions Committee of Faversham Golf Club will be final in all matters.
- All competitions are open to Ladies, Gentlemen and Junior golfers who have a competition CONGU handicap, unless otherwise stated. **Please note:** Any entrant with a non-competition (such as those given by GolfShake) handicap is welcome to play **but will not be eligible** (nor will the team/partner of) **for any prize**. A maximum handicap of 36 for Ladies and Junior Girls and of 28 for Men and Junior Boys will apply. Players with CONGU handicaps above these limits may compete, subject to the maximum allowances shown here.
- **Mixed teams will comprise of 2 men and 2 ladies to win a Mixed category prize.** Visitors' teams must comprise of ONLY visiting golfers; any team with one or more members will be categorised as a members' team.
- Entry forms must be completed correctly with CDH numbers for all playing golfers and should contain valid contact details (including an email address) for the main contact. Forms must be received with your full entry fee at Faversham Golf Club by the closing date of Friday 24th May 2019. Should your entry be incomplete in any way, the office will return your entry form and fee to you at your specified address.
- Entry fees **MUST** be received at the time of booking. **Places will not be reserved without payment** being received by the office.
- All entries are received on a first-come, first-served basis. If any given competition is deemed to be fully booked, we will return your entry form and fee to you at the designated address.
- The office will endeavour to accommodate start-time preferences. The start sheets for each day's competition will be displayed on the Belmont Open Week noticeboard at Faversham Golf Club from the beginning of April and start-times will be notified by email or telephone to competitors at the time of booking.
- **Cancellations:** should any member of your team be unable to play, please arrange your own replacement and advise the Secretary / Manager's office accordingly. Should you be unable to find a replacement, please contact the office to see if substitutes are available from within the Faversham Golf Club membership.
- The prize-giving for the weeks' competitions will take place on **Saturday 6th June 2020 at approximately 6.30pm**. Should you be unable to attend, please make direct arrangements with the office to collect your prize(s) at a time convenient to you.
- The Clubhouse dress-code is smart-casual and must be adhered to by visitors and members alike. Smart denim jeans are permitted, however all clothing must be smart in appearance and shirts must have a collar. Tailored shorts are allowed both on the course and in the Clubhouse (no cargo shorts or board-shorts). Beachwear or casual wear – such as flip-flops or track-suits – will not be permitted in the Clubhouse.
